SUMMARY OF CLINICAL ACTIVITIES

We perform electromyography (EMG), diagnostic ultrasound, and a number of image guided procedures using fluoroscopy and ultrasound.

I am affiliated with both the UCSF Department of Neurological Surgery, taking care of patients and collaborating with UCSF staff neurosurgeons in Napa, and the UC Davis Department of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, teaching visiting medical students, residents and fellows.

Concurrently I serve as the medical director of the Wellness Center/Synergy Medical Fitness Center at Queen of the Valley Medical Center, which requires less than an hour or two of my time per month.

SUMMARY OF TEACHING HOURS:

I have taught one to two fellows per year since 2004. The fellowship was temporarily approved as an ACGME sports medicine fellowship until the temporary criteria elapsed in 2013. All six fellows who took the ACGME sports medicine examination passed on the first attempt.

Teaching at conferences and symposia has averaged 50-70 hours per year, not including preparation time. Teaching of medical students, residents, fellows and visiting faculty at our practice is on the order of 1-2 hours per day or approximately 300 hours per year.
